University of Winnipeg

- Liberal Arts institution
- Primarily undergraduate, 6,000+ FTE
- Downtown, urban, commuter campus
- 40 Library staff (8 librarians)
- Some recent developments
 - Strong Information Literacy program
 - Over 120 licensed databases
 - 9,000 serials (8,000 electronic)
 - Virtual reference from 8am-11pm + weekends
- UL is a former Systems Librarian/Developer

Linux

- Servers include Windows 2000, Mac OS X, Solaris, Linux
- New servers are Mac or Linux – goal is to faze out Solaris and Windows
 - Video/Audio on Mac
 - OAI repository, vRef, Discussion groups Linux
- Developing expertise in LAMP environment from Windows/Cold Fusion/Access
- Skills for Linux transferable to Mac and visa versa

VWCUL

- Virtual Western Canadian University Library
- GODOT/Citation Manager/dbWiz
 - GODOT provides OpenURL linking as well as proprietary linking
 - Citation Manager provides web-based citation harvesting (via GODOT) and management
 - dbWiz will provide federated searching and resource discovery tools
- One of the best OpenURL linking systems
- Designed for consortial environments
- Competes with products costing 10s of thousands and works as well or better

RAKIM

- Virtual reference software developed by Rob Casson (Miami University, Ohio)
- Have had vRef service for 3 years
 - Went from HumanClick-LSSI-RAKIM
 - LSSI was a bad experience, 70%+ of sessions broke for one reason or another
 - RAKIM was much more robust on same network
- Less functionality than an LSSI but seems to be developing a following and ports are happening already

ePrints

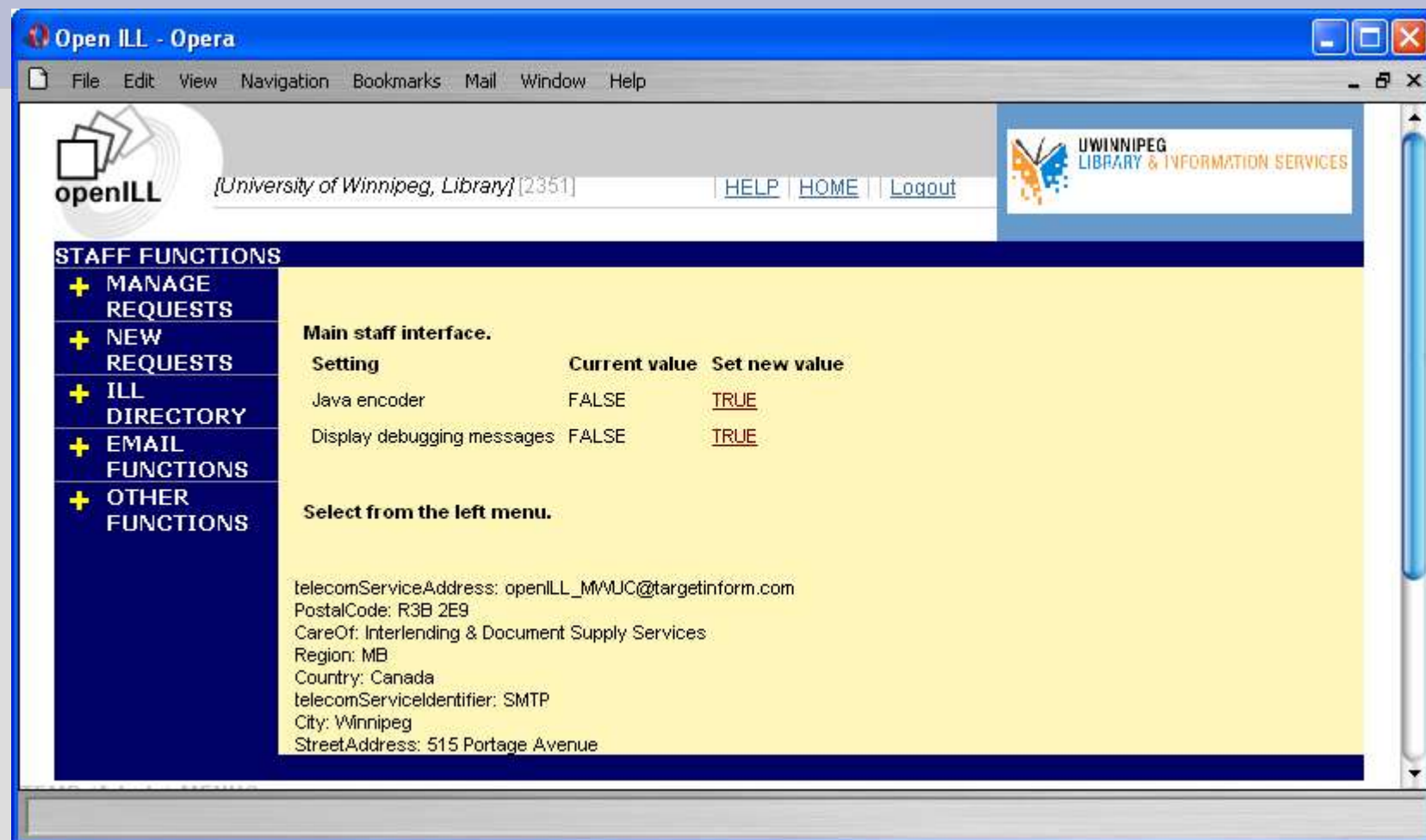
- ePrints for institutional repository and eJournal website
 - eCommons::Research
 - Canadian Bulletin Medical History
 - Also looking at using for a discipline-based repository
- Widely used, standard OS community, regular updates
- Not sure how it will compare in the long-term to DSpace from MIT, but very good functions

phpBB

- Had been using O'Reilly's WebBoard for 3 years, concerns about longevity and pricing after sold to another vendor
- Up and running with phpBB in very short time
 - Provides most of the same functions
 - Some features better than commercial products
 - Widely used and mature product
- Staff able to make changes to basic product
- Good way to develop skills in more traditional LAMP environment

OpenILL

- U of Winnipeg managed open source InterLibrary Loan system project
 - Fully ISO/IPIG compliant ILL system
 - LDAP-based Directory following IPIG schema
 - Designed for consortial environment or stand-alone
 - 2nd release in Fall 2003
 - Cold Fusion, Fusebox 3, MySQL, LDAP
- Developed because commercial products had been flaky and ephemeral, little stability

Reset

UofW and Cold Fusion

- Have developed a number of Cold Fusion apps over last 4 years
 - Content Management system
 - Information Literacy manual
 - Innopac add-ons (labels, eJournals, etc.)
- Not open source environment, but our applications and many others are freely available
- Biggest advantage is ease of use
- With 40 staff, 6 are doing CF development

Value of OS at UofW

- vRef with commercial product
 - LSSI cost \$15,000 1st year & startup
 - \$10,000 per year, per seat
 - Went from 400 interactions per month to < 100
 - How many clients will not return?
- vRef with open source product
 - RAKIM cost \$0 1st year (redeployed old staff Pentium PC)
 - Returned to 3-400 interactions per month
- Hard to put a value on customer satisfaction!
